Precious Memories of George Hailey, Jr.



On March 6, 1915, in Oakwood, Texas, George Hailey, Sr. and Izelia Middleton Hailey, became the proud parents of a sweet baby boy whom they named, "George Jr.". He was the youngest of eight children.

George was raised in the Shiloh Community. He attended and received his education at St. Paul / Shiloh Public School in the Timesville Community.

George accepted Christ into his life as a child and attended Shiloh A.M.E. Oakwood and later after he moved to Fairfield, he united with Jones Chapel United Methodist Church. He was a faithful member until his health failed.

George married Ellen Edna Cooper in October 6, 1945. This union was blessed with six children.

George did ranch work. He was in the U.S. Army, and served in World War II. George was a member of Red Oak Masonic Lodge #59, in Oakwood, Texas.
