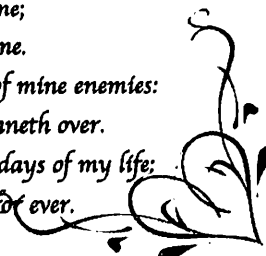
The 23rd Psalms
