Obituary

Arthur Lee Sessom completed life on this earth Monday evening, April 5, 1999, at Mesa Lutheran Hospital in Mesa, Arizona. His life began in Herman, Arkansas on July 23, 1914. Arthur was an only child from the union of Luvenia Curley and Guy Williams and reared by his grandparents, Pearl and John Sessom in East St Louis, Illinois where he received his formal education, graduating from Lincoln High School. He remained a resident of East St. Louis, Illinois until February 1998, when he and his wife moved to Mesa, Arizona.
