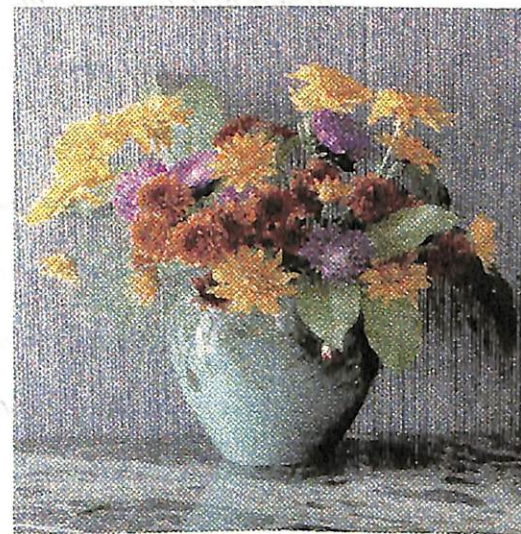

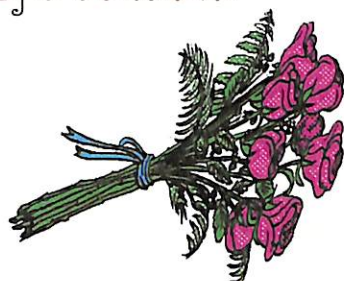


Home At Last
