The late Ms. Naggie Lee Davis, was born August 04, 1910.

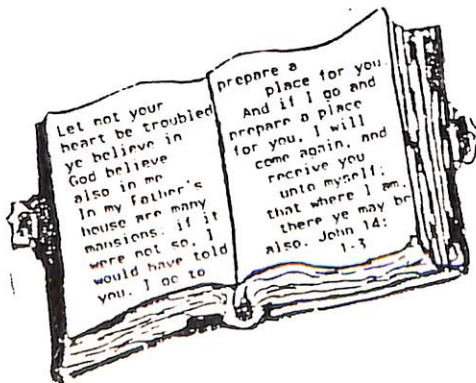
She accept christ as her savior at an early age. And united with Haven United Methodist Church.
