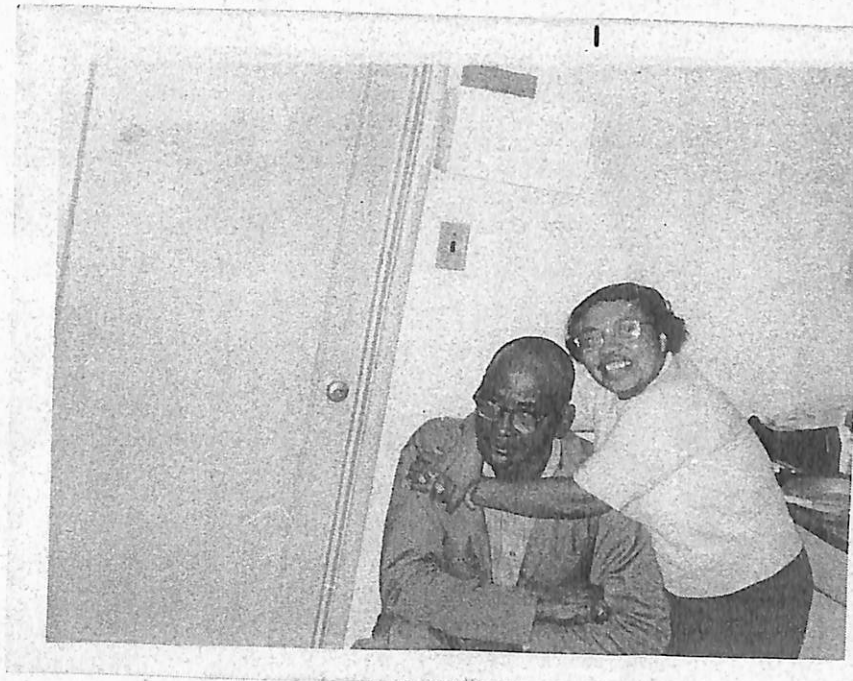
*Bro. Jason accepted Christ as his personal Savior at an early age. He worked as a carpenter for many years and retired in that field of employment.*

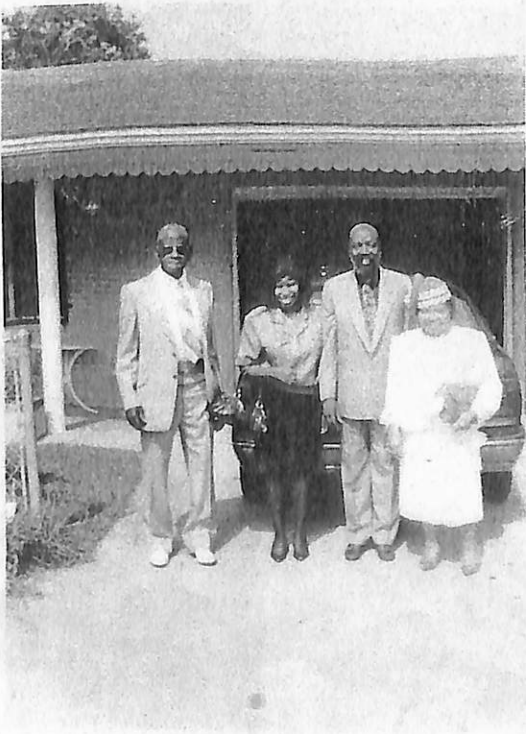
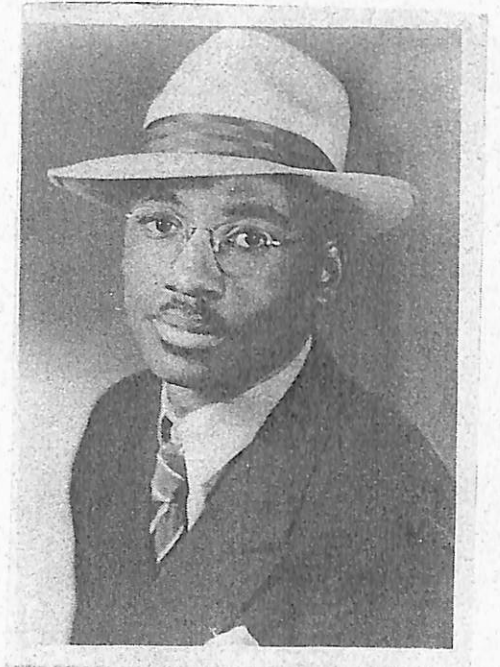
