




Obituary

Rodney was a star athlete. He began competing in track as a junior high student at J.Z. George High School. He polished his skills as a sprinter during his sophomore, junior, and senior years. As a junior, he finished second in the 400 meter dash at the state meet. He also competed in the triple jump. He finished third as a member of the mile relay team. As a senior, Rodney finished first in the 400 meter dash and placed second in the triple jump. He received an athletic scholarship from the University of Mississippi. While there, he poured his heart and soul into track competition.

He competed as a member of the U.S.

4x400 meter relay team at the 2006

World Junior Championships in
Beijing, China, bringing home a gold

medal. At the 2006 NCAA MidEast Outdoor Regional he qualified as a member of the 4x400 meter relay team and in the 400 meters. He finished ninth in the 400 meters at the 2006 SEC Outdoor Championships and was a member of the 4x400 meter relay team that finished eighth at the 2006 SEC Indoor Championships with a time of 48.31. He was a member of the 4x400 meter relay team that finished fifth at the 2006 SEC Indoor Championships. He was the top collegiate finisher in the 400 meters at the McCravy Memorial where he posted a time of 47.70. His top indoor times include 21.25 in the 200 meters and 47.34 in the 400 meters. His outdoor bests include 21.79 in the 200 meters and 46.82 in the 400 meters. Rodney Lydale Lockhart is gone, but he will never be forgotten!
