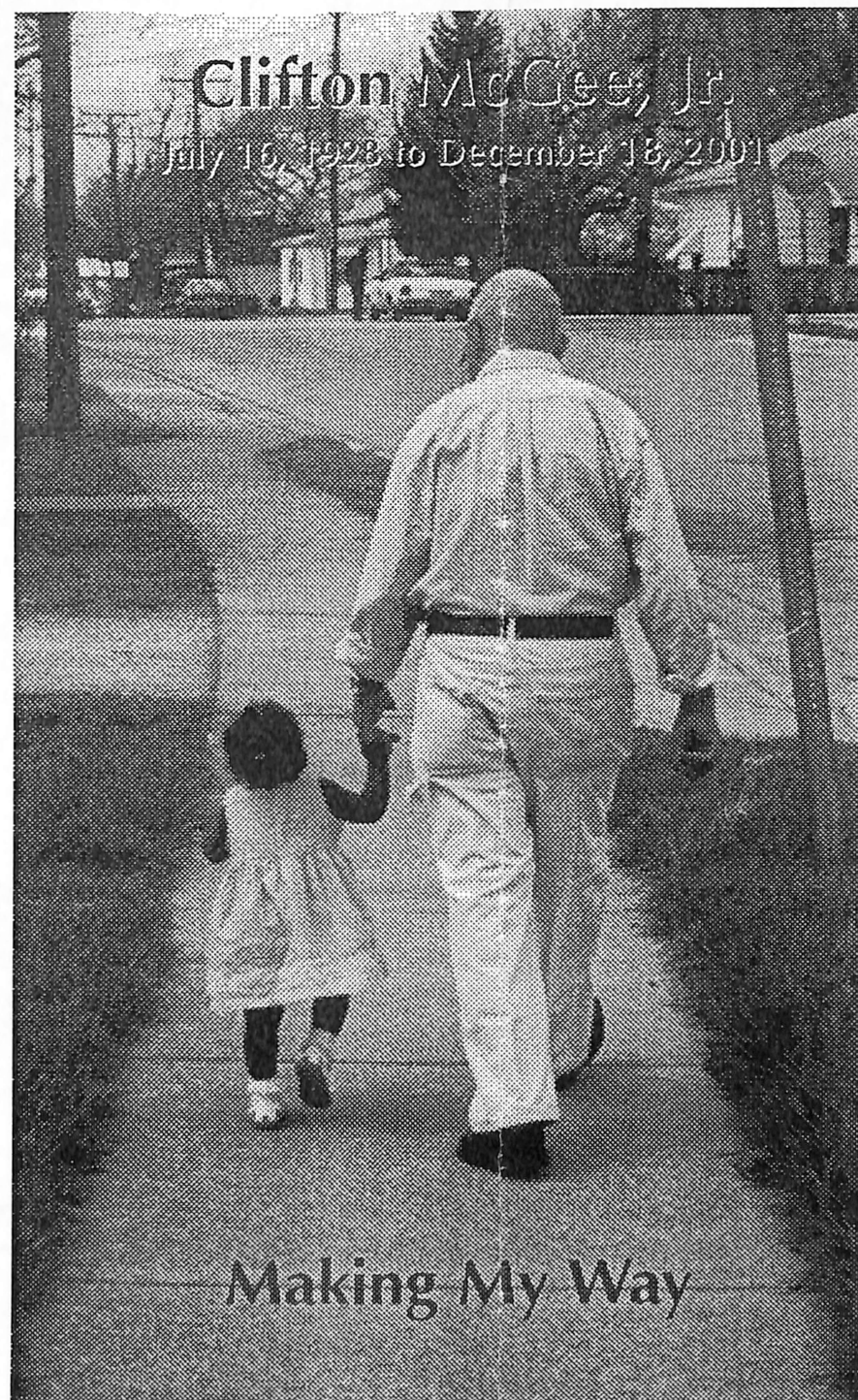

## Clifton McGee, Jr.

July 16, 1928 to December 18, 2001

Clifton McGee, Jr was born July 16, 1928, in Dallas, Texas, son of the late Clifton Sr. and Mildred Procter McGee. He is survived by his wife, Delores McGee, whom he married June 10, 1955.

He served for 21 years in the U.S. Army. He served two tours in the Korean War and one tour in Vietnam.
