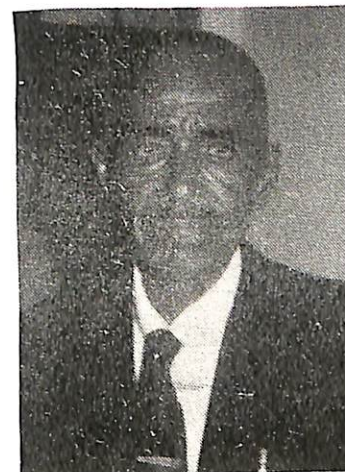

THE OBITUARY

We feel that could he but speak, he would say: For me life is over, I am at rest. Life goes on for those I love best. No worry of the present or concern of the future, I have no care. No more of life's troubles do I have to bear. I rest in peace a life well spent, I go with the angels that were Heaven sent. I worry no more, of precious life to save.

Our beloved husband and father departed this life on August 20, 1974 in the pulpit of the R.Z.U.A. Headquarters Building; while attending the R.Z.U.A. Annual Conference. He had just completed the Conference's introductory Sermon for the Conference using the following Text: Isaiah: 38 Chapter the second and fourth verses, "Then Hezekiah turned his face toward the walls, and prayed unto the Lord." "4th, "Then came the word of the Lord to Isaiah saying," etc. Immediately after the sermon he was called from labor to reward,

William Ghee was born November 21, 1885 to the parents of Clabon and Sallie Ghee of Lunenburg County. He was a member of a family of 16 children, 12 boys and four girls.

William attended the Public School of Lunenburg and was a faithful Sunday School and Church worker. In the early years, William joined the Rehoboth Baptist Church and was baptized by the Rev. Patton Anderson. In 1902 he joined the Tussekiah Baptist Church of Lunenburg County. During this time he served the Sunday School as superintendent and teacher. In 1935 he changed his membership from the Baptist Church to the R.Z.U.A. Thus holding his membership with the Gilfield Church of Victoria, Va. He was ordained to ministry by Rev. R. E. Rice in 1935. In 1905 William was married to the late Frances Hardy. To this union was born six children, five boys and one girl.

In 1952 he was married a second time to Vernell Mitchell Quarles Ghee. To this union came one step-son and one step-daughter. Each and every one of his children loved him dearly. Our record shows that Rev. Ghee was ordained at St. Stephen Church and during his life served as pastor of the following Churches: Dundas Chappel, Bethelham Mission, Pleasant Hill, Little Bethel, Prospect, St. Taylor, William Grove, Union Church, Mt. Zion, Bethel Memorial, and St. Stephen. At the time of death he was pastoring St. Stephen, Union and St. Taylor.

Rev. Ghee leaves to mourn their loss a wife; four sons; one daughter; one step-son; one step-daughter; a brother; 16 grandchildren; seven sisters-in-law; one brother-in-law, a large number of great-grandchildren, and a host of nieces and nephews.

The family will forever remember the close relationship of this family but we know that God does all things well; Thus we can only say:

He has kept the faith.*
