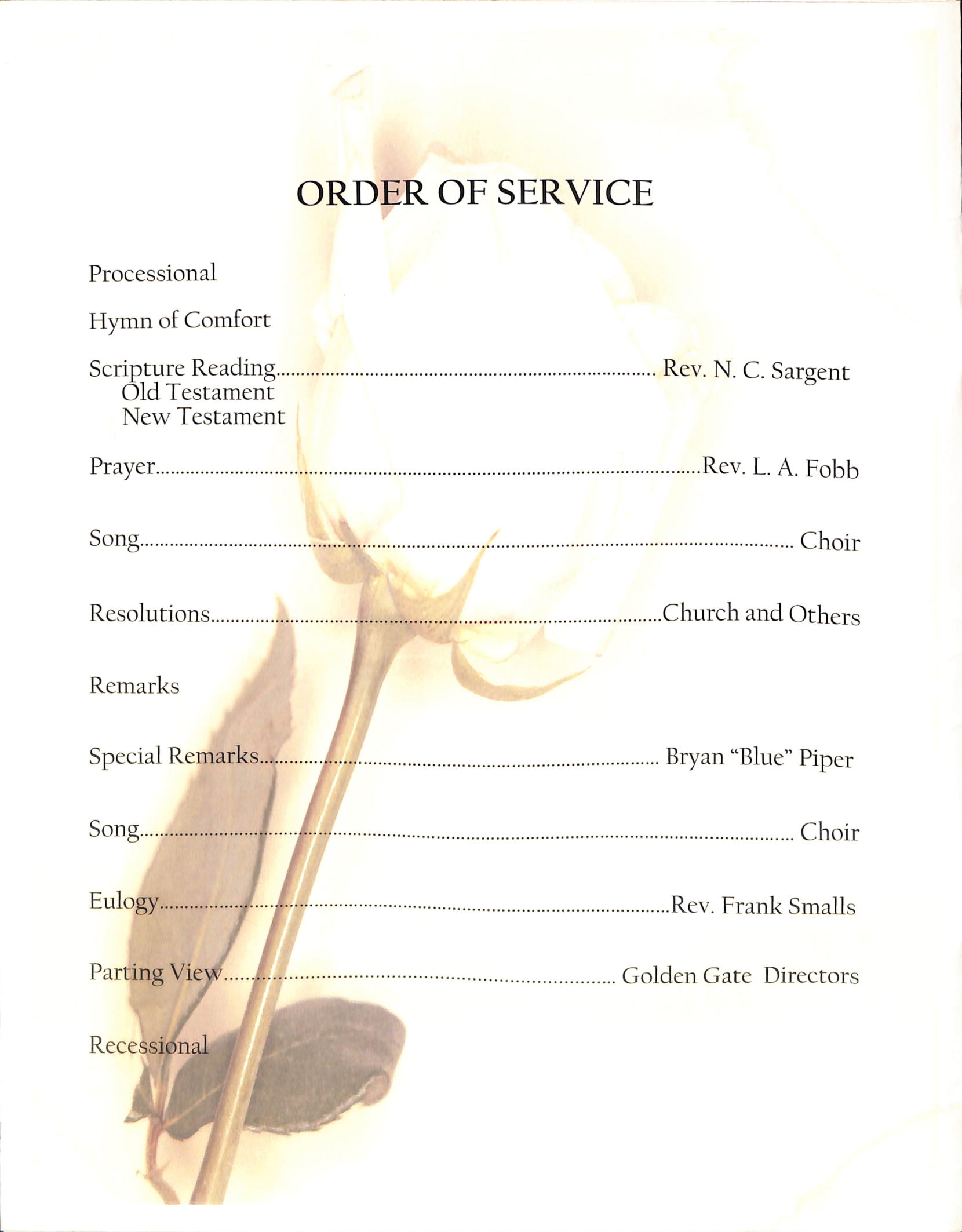

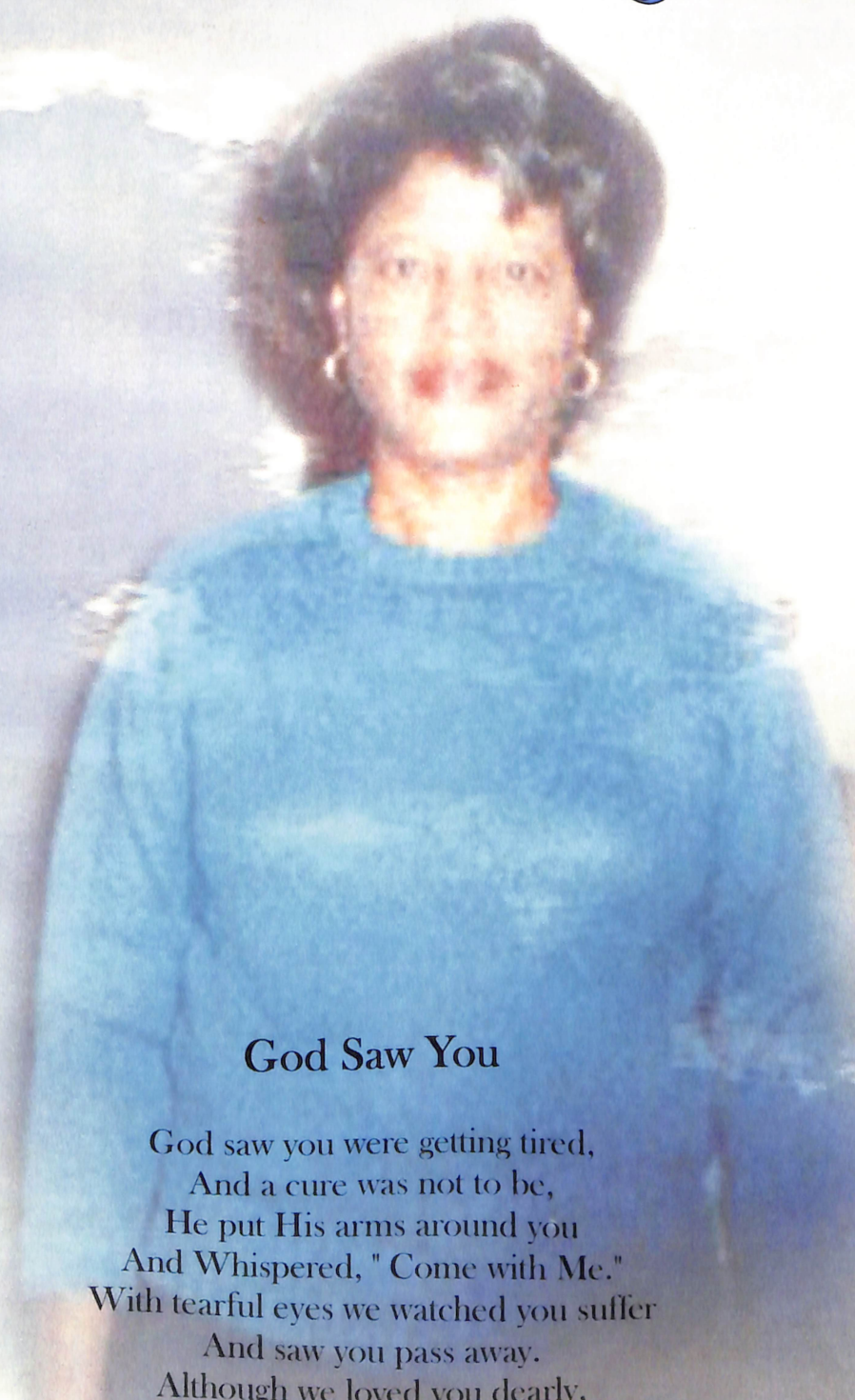
## OBITUARY
