He accepted Christ into his life and united with Jones Chapel.

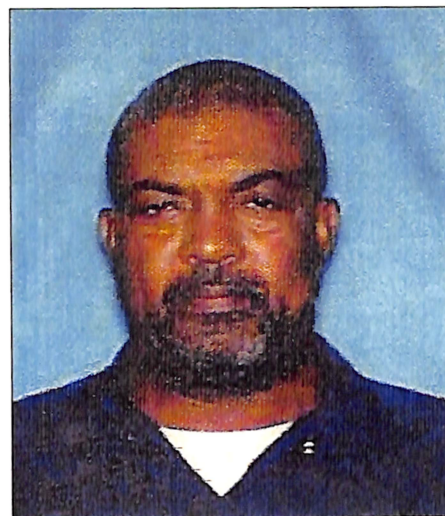
Harvell met and married Lillie Brackens.
