On January 19, 2009, Jesus, the heavenly hosts, his beloved brother, Benjamin Hunt, Jr. and other relatives and friends welcomed him into heaven.

Joseph “JB” attended Humbert Woods Elementary School and later graduated from Burke High School in 1954. In 1956, he graduated from Denmark Area Trade School.

He was self-employed as a Contractor (“one of the best in Charleston, SC”). He enjoyed working in maintenance for the Charleston County School District where he was employed for nineteen (19) years. After retiring in 1996, he became the bus driver for the Senior Citizen Program on James Island, SC.

Joseph, at the age of five (5), began his career singing on the senior choir with his grandmother and other choir members. In 1954, he became a member of St. James United Methodist Church where he served

faithfully on the following organizations: Class Leader of Class #4, Member of Trustee Board, United Methodist Men, Finance Committee, Senior Choir and Male Choir. He was also a member and business manager of the Sensational Traveling Echoes of Johns Island for forty-eight (48) years.

He was united in holy matrimony to Bernice Cohen on March 17, 1962. Their children are; Lora McQueen (Jerome), Eileen Mikell (Anthony), Pastor Joseph Hunt, Jr. (Cassandra), Jacqueline Triplett, Darren Kerry Hunt (Irene) and the late Ellis Rodney Hunt.

Some others to win.


I fought manfully onward,
