Judge Richard Ganaway was North Charleston first black City Council member. He served as a Summary Court Judge and Honorary Base Commander 437th FMS.

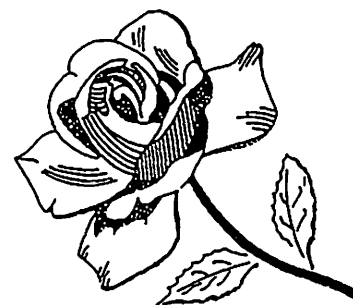
