## Sis Estella Grant

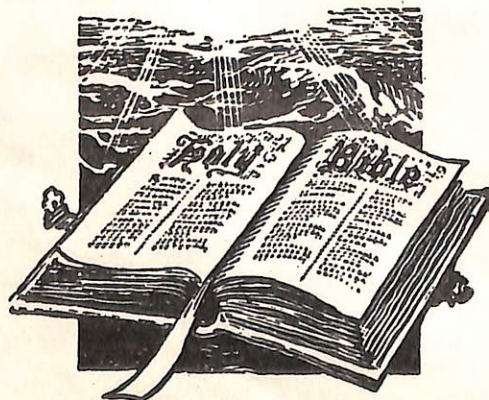
A loved one has departed from this earth for another land. "A city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God." Hebrews 11:10

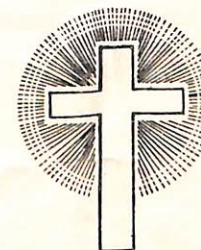
