Obituary of Anthony Blair LaCour

Blair was born on January 15, 1954, in Shreveport, Louisiana. He was the sixth child of Harry Arie and Glotha Friedman LaCour. Because his mother died when he was an infant, Blair grew up in the home of his aunt and uncle, Edward and Mary LaCour Metoyer. Blair was blessed in that he had two loving primary families.

Educated in Shreveport at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Elementary and Jesuit High School, Blair graduated from Captain Shreve High School, where he was active in the drama club. He attended Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana where he obtained a BA degree in Journalism. He was an outstanding student and loved writing. During this period he married his college sweetheart, Mamie Boutte. Blair moved to St. Paul in 1980 and made this his home.

A devout Catholic, Blair was a member of St. Edward's Catholic Church for many years. He had a wonderful voice and loved singing in the choir. Most recently he attended St. Peter Claver Catholic Church.

Working in training/development and in sales, Blair traveled often and grew from the challenges these jobs offered. He enjoyed sharing stories about his travels and the friendships made. "It's in the book," he used to say. He loved instructing and helping others in any way that he could.

Blair was a warm, fun loving and family oriented person. He embraced five siblings from his birth parents and three from his adopted family. He shared a special closeness with all of his nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by both sets of parents, two brothers, Wendell (Sonny) and Roland, and one sister Imogene.
