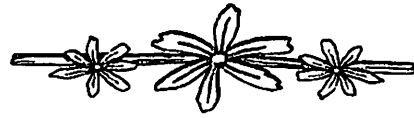

Please forgive me.

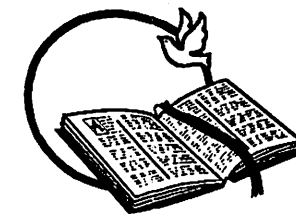
